How to use this pack

Print the helper pages, laminate them, and hang them up in the kitchen, bathroom and bedroom.

Determine what format you want to use the chore cards with.

You can use a calendar sized pocket chart, in which case you want multiple copies of the cards. You place the Monday-Sunday cards across the top, and the chores your child is to do underneath the day cards. As your child completes their chores, they turn the cards over. This works best for children who have different chores each day.

Another option is to use Velcro dots and poster boards. You can put the day and night cards at the top of the column, and the daily chores underneath it. They can remove the chores from the list when they are finished.

This works best for children who have the same chores each day.

The last option is to laminate the chore cards, and punch a hole in the corner. Put them on a metal ring, and let your child carry them around with them as they work to complete their chores. When the chores are complete, they report back to you. This works best for older children who do not want a chore chart on the wall.


